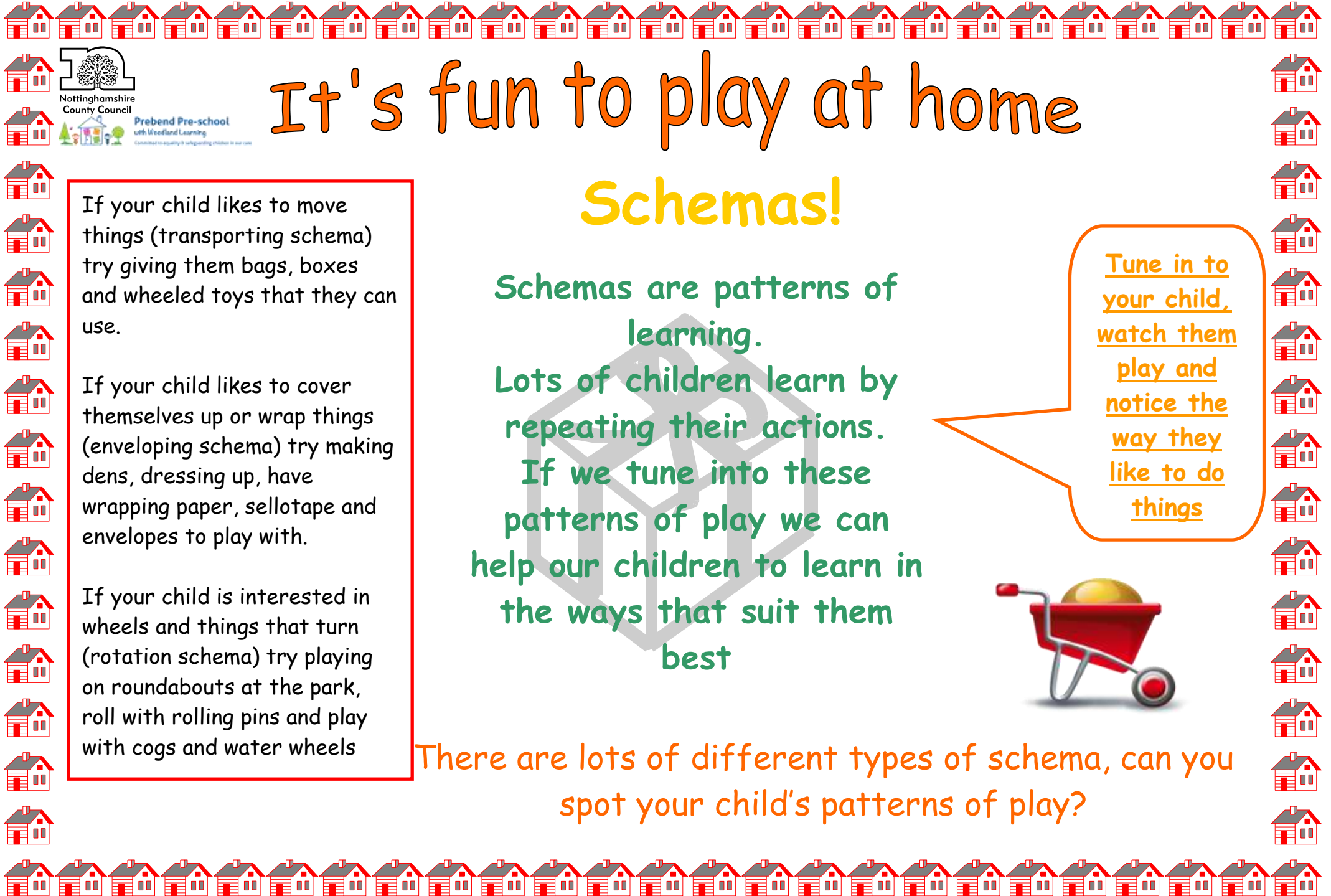


It's fun to play at home



Schemas!

If your child likes to move things (transporting schema) try giving them bags, boxes and wheeled toys that they can use.

If your child likes to cover themselves up or wrap things (enveloping schema) try making dens, dressing up, have wrapping paper, sellotape and envelopes to play with.

If your child is interested in wheels and things that turn (rotation schema) try playing on roundabouts at the park, roll with rolling pins and play with cogs and water wheels

Schemas are patterns of learning.

Lots of children learn by repeating their actions.

If we tune into these patterns of play we can help our children to learn in the ways that suit them best

Tune in to your child, watch them play and notice the way they like to do things
